RESOLUTION 2026-03 BENEFIT ASSESSMENT UNIT AND SPECIAL TAX YEAR 2026-2027

WHEREAS The mission of the DOHFPD is to provide fire prevention, emergency response and emergency medical services throughout its boundaries; and

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the citizens and taxpayers of the Dobbins/Oregon House Fire Protection District, that the district utilizes the legally authorized funds available to it in providing improved fire protection and lifesaving and rescue services in the district; and

WHEREAS the DOHFPD is authorized pursuant to the authority provided in California Government Code Section 50078 et seq. and Article XIID of the California Constitution, to levy assessments for fire suppression services; and

WHEREAS an assessment for fire suppression and protection services has been given the distinctive designation of the “Fire Suppression and Protection Services Assessment” (“Assessment”) and is primarily described as encompassing the Authority jurisdictional boundaries, which covers the district; and

WHEREAS District assessments are calculated and levied based on the rate schedules adopted by the District Board and they are not levied based on the value of the customer’s real property.

WHEREAS it is equally important, that the district’s appropriation of tax revenues never exceed our legal limit, which would result in complex and costly rebate processes...

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED; by the proposed adoption, the Benefit Assessment Unit will remain the same for the fiscal year 2026-2027.

IT IS ALSO RESOLVED; in addition to the existing benefit assessment, the district will impose a special tax. We will report a special tax value of **\$9.10** This cost results in a proposed assessment rate of **TWENTY-ONE DOLLARS AND SIXTY CENTS (\$21.60)** per single-family equivalent benefit unit for fiscal year 2026-27. The special tax will be adjusted on an annual basis based upon Consumer Price Indices. This was approved by two-thirds of the voters at the November 5, 2002, election.

WHEREAS documentation used in determination of the Fiscal Year 2026-27 Benefit Assessment and Special Tax has been available to the public prior to the board’s determination in this matter as required by Government Code Section 7910.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Dobbins/Oregon House Fire Protection District that:
